KITCO RECEIVES ANOTHER CREDITOR PROTECTION EXTENSION

Montreal, QC, June 26, 2013 — In defending itself against the Québec Revenue Agency's allegations of 2011, Kitco Metals Inc. (Kitco) had been granted creditor protection by the courts. Upon the expiry of its last eight-month extension, Kitco once again appeared before the Superior Court of Québec on June 25, 2013.

Kitco was granted a further extension to its creditor protection by The Honorable Mark Schrager. In view of the company's sound conduct of its business and better-than-forecasted financial performance, the Court granted Kitco an extension of creditor protection until March 14, 2014.

Among Kitco's lines of business is the purchase of scrap precious metals. Kitco pays its suppliers sales taxes on these purchases and receives tax credits for the corresponding amounts. It is then the suppliers' responsibility to remit these taxes to the Québec Revenue Agency. Alleging that some of these suppliers have not paid back the taxes owed to it, Québec Revenue Agency is unjustly holding Kitco responsible for these unremitted taxes. Québec Revenue Agency's issuance of assessments for these taxes has forced Kitco to file for creditor protection.

Kitco strongly contests these assessments and will continue to defend itself vigorously against them.
